

KMF score highly

 Following a recent visit to its Newcastle-under-Lyme factory by a group of industry leaders, KMF (Precision Sheet Metal) received confirmation that its drive for manufacturing excellence is delivering the desired results.

The visit, part of Inside Manufacturing Enterprise's (IME) regular company visit programme designed to highlight best practice in manufacturing was attended by representatives of engineering and manufacturing companies from across the Midlands.
