KMF keeps silver aero-awards

Newcastle under Lyne sheet metal sub-contractor KMF (Precision Sheet Metal) has maintained the prestigious Silver SC21 aerospace accreditation after undergoing its first annual assessment since winning the Award last year.

The 2012 certificate was presented to KMF's Business Development Manager, Lyndon Royall, by Rolls Royce's Global Supply Chain Executive, Andy Page, at the Farnborough Air Show.

Royall said, 'This ongoing accreditation to SC21 Silver is confirmation of the commitment of everyone at KMF towards building on the work we are doing for customers in the aerospace sector.
